3. Selection Procedure

Ist Selection : The 1st selection institutions (Overseas Korean embassies or Domestic designated universities) will draft a selections standard based on the criteria provisioned by NIIED, and will recommend qualified applicants according to its respective standards.

2nd Selection : The NIIED selection committee will select the most successful candidates from the pool of applicants recommended by the 1st selection institutions.

3rd Selection : Only candidates who were recommended by a Korean embassy and have passed the 2nd selection successfully will be evaluated for admission. Successful candidates will gain admission from at least one of the three universities.
